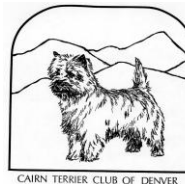

ENTRY FEES for all regular classes (ME, SE, JE): - \$16.00 per class
 if entry is received by 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, June 8, 2011.

Day-of-test entry fee is \$20.00 for the regular classes.

Endurance Earthdog pre-entry fee is \$28.00 and day-of-test entry fee is \$32.00.
NOTE: If entering both Master and Senior classes as an Endurance Earthdog entry, check both class blocks on the entry form and submit the Endurance Earthdog entry fee amount.
 Introduction to Quarry entry fee \$10.00 per dog, both pre-entry and day of test.

All entry forms must be completed in full to be acceptable.

Please be prepared with your dog's AKC registration information.

We are not able to look up any registration info at the site.

Dogs completing a title in the regular classes may move up to the next level
 if the test secretary receives a move-up form before the closing time of the next test.
 See the test secretary if you complete a title.

This test is open to dogs six months of age or older that have been registered with the AKC, or have been granted a PAL/ILP number, or have an acceptable foreign registration number. Dogs must be one of the earthdog-eligible breeds: Dachshunds, Miniature Schnauzers, and Terrier breeds: Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Glen of Imaal, Parson Russell, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Norfolk, Norwich, Rat, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Smooth Fox, Welsh, West Highland White, Wire Fox.

Dogs who pass Introduction to Quarry Class will receive AKC ribbons.

Qualifiers in Junior, Senior and Master Classes will receive AKC rosettes.

Newly Titled dogs in the Master, Senior and Junior Regular Classes will receive AKC Rosettes.

Any Master Earthdog Titled dog qualifying in both Master and Senior Classes during the same numbered AKC event will receive an Endurance Earthdog Qualifying Rosette.

Any Master Earthdog Titled dog completing its 5th qualifying Endurance Earthdog Leg during the same numbered AKC event will receive an Endurance Earthdog Title Rosette.

☞ A pewter bread plate will be awarded as the CH Cairmar Carefree, ME, memorial trophy to the first Cairn Terrier to earn a Master Earthdog title. Offered by Mary Lou & Dick Wilde

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- **Please read the Regulations for Earthdog Tests before entering the test.** The regulations may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606-3390, Phone (919) 233-9780, or online at www.akc.org.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible entry forms. Incomplete entry forms can NOT be accepted. Fees must accompany entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- Dogs must be at least 6 months old to participate in regular and non-regular classes. AKC registered dogs of eligible breeds that are spayed or neutered or have an ILP/PAL registration are allowed to participate.
- Bitches in season are not eligible for entry and are not allowed within 100 feet of any testing area. Entry fees will be refunded after the closing date with a letter from a veterinarian.
- For the safety of all participants, all dogs must be held on a short leash. **Flexi users must keep the lead locked short (under 6 feet). This rule will be strictly enforced! A solid 4 to 6 foot lead shall be used when walking the dog to the test area or release point.**
- All dogs are to be under control while on the test grounds. No dogs, other than those in immediate judging order, are allowed within 100 feet of the test areas.
- Dogs not present at the testing area when they are called will be moved to the end of the class, except for Master Earthdog class. Dogs not present within five minutes after its brace is called will be marked absent per AKC rules (Chapter 1, section 14).
- Entries for each dog must be made on a separate AKC Entry Form.
- Entries will not be acknowledged by mail.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Test Committee.
- **RUNNING ORDER FOR TESTS:** Dogs in each class will be run in the order in which the entries are received. Multiple entries by the same handler will be separated in running order to facilitate the smooth running of the test. The running order of each class will be posted prior to the start of the class. Dogs not ready to run will be moved to the end of the class, except in Master Earthdog. Judges will not wait for late-arriving dogs.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

On I-25 (heading South from Denver): Take Lincoln Avenue Exit 193, east to Parker Road (Hwy 83). Go South on Parker Rd to Hess Road. Go left on Hess Road, it becomes Hilltop Rd. Go 3.9 miles on Hilltop Road and take a left onto East Singing Hills Road (Cnty Rd. 24). Go East on Singing Hills Rd. 6.4 mi to County Road 21; South on County Rd. 21 3 mi to County Road 154; East on County Rd. 154 less than a mile to 5777; house is on left with "Wilde Oaks" sign.

On I-25 (heading North from Colorado Springs): At Castle Rock, take Franktown Exit 182, East on Hwy 86 to Elizabeth. Left on County Rd. 21 after Elizabeth. North on Cnty. Rd. 21 to County Road 154; East on County Rd. 154 less than a mile to 5777; driveway is on left with "Wilde Oaks" sign.
