Please be on time for your class, but above all, be flexible. Delays are not uncommon.

Pre-entry discounts apply only to entries received by the test secretary before 4:00 pm on Monday, August 9, 2021.

Tests and Awards

Introduction to Quarry – Open to all dogs. Non-regular class; dogs do not earn a title in this class. Qualifiers receive a Rosette.

Junior Earthdog – Open to all dogs except dogs that have received a Senior qualifying leg. Qualifiers receive a rosette.

Senior Earthdog – Open to all dogs that have earned a JE before the close of entries. Qualifiers receive a rosette.

Master Earthdog – Open to all dogs that have earned an SE before close of entries. Qualifiers receive a rosette.

EE - Open to all dogs that have earned an ME before close of entries. Dogs must qualify in both Master and Senior classes at the same test in order to earn a qualifying EE leg.

New Titles – CTCD offers a new title rosette to dogs that complete a JE, SE, or ME title.

Notice to Exhibitors

- Earthdog tests are held rain or shine. Weather is unpredictable. Bring both shade and rain cover for you and your dog, and plenty of water!
- Dogs may enter only one regular class. Dogs with Master titles may enter more than one regular class. Dogs need not qualify in Intro to enter the Junior Earthdog class.
- The running order will be posted and followed using AKC rules. This includes pre-entries.
- Dogs must be kept on leash and under control while on the grounds.
- Dogs are not allowed within 100 feet of the test areas.
- As bitches in season are not eligible, please leave them at home or confine them to your setup.
- This test is being held on private property. Please honor posted signs, notices, and any requests or directions from the site owner.
- Pick up after your dog. No exceptions!
- If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of CTCD, it is impossible to begin or complete these tests, no refund of entries will be given.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for any checks returned for insufficient funds.

Take Delbert Road and Co. Road 186 to Pikes Peak Road in Elbert County (19 minutes, 10.9 miles)

From the Show Site:

Follow D st, N 8th Ave, and 5th St to US-85 S (5 minutes, 1.8 miles)

Take US-34 E to Co. Road 49 in Kersey (9 minutes, 6.9 miles)

Get on I-76 W in Hudson (19 minutes, 20.5 miles)

Follow I-76 W and E-470S to E Smoky Hill Road in Aurora. (36 min, 41.3 mi)

Eligibility: Dogs six months of age or older and registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in earthdog tests, as are spayed and neutered dogs. The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in earthdog tests: Dachshunds, American Heirless Terrier, Australian Terriers, Bedlington Terriers, Border Terriers, Cairn Terriers, Cesky Terriers, Dandie Dinmont Terriers, Glen of Imaal Terriers, Jagdterrier, Fox Terriers (Smooth and Wirehaired), Lakeland Terriers, Manchester Terriers, Miniature Bull Terriers, Miniature Pinschers, Miniature Schnauzers, Norfolk Terriers, Norwich Terriers, Parson Russell Terriers, Rat Terriers, Russell Terriers, Scottish Terriers, Sealyham Terriers, Silky Terriers, Skye Terriers, Welsh Terriers, West Highland White Terriers, and Yorkshire Terriers. Dogs of an eligible breed must be AKC registered, Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) registered, or Foundation Stock Service (FSS) registered to participate.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test and shall not be allowed within 100 feet of any testing area during the running of any class. Bitches in season are allowed at the general test site but should not be allowed to distract other dogs during the test hours.

The Cairn Terrier Club of Denver and its officers assumes NO responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injures to any child not under the control of his/her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor, handler, or spectator whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviors may, at the discretion of the Test Committee, be asked to leave the Test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
