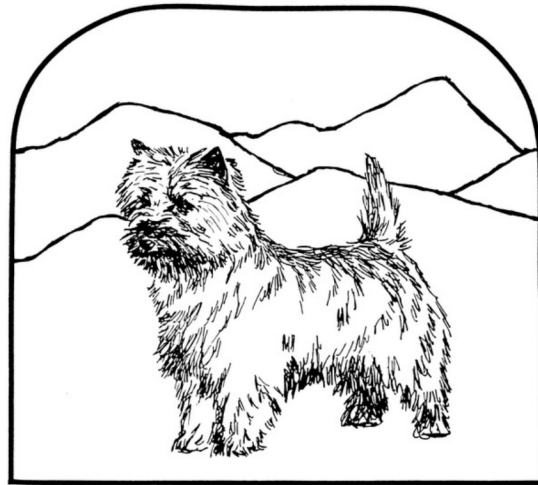

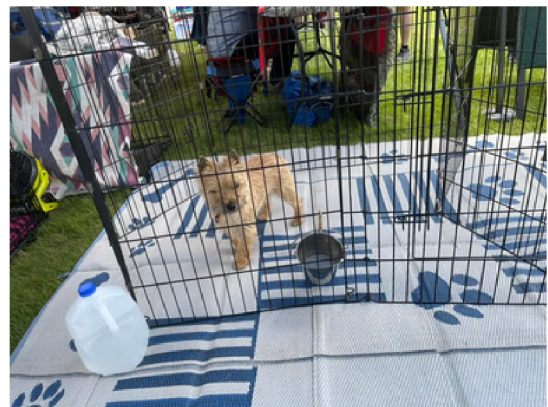
Wow! It's been a busy summer already!

Entry Method - First Received  
Entries will open September 2, 2023 at 8am MST at the Trial Secretary's address listed in the premium ONLY, or via online at [www.harmonydogsports.com](http://www.harmonydogsports.com). All entries received before this date will be returned. Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed.

Pre-entries close October 1, 2023 at 11:45pm MST after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

If the trial has not filled, Day-Of-Trial entries will be accepted on the day of trial, up to a maximum of 50 runs. Day-of runs will be fit in as space allows throughout the day. It may be a long wait. Pre-entry is strongly encouraged.
